As a Superintendent working with Hallen Environmental Services, LLC., Mr. DeMuccio is responsible for the scheduling, deployment, management, safety and productivity of between 10 to 25 crews and 15 to 30 pieces of equipment daily on as many project sites. Currently his primary Client responsibilities are for Con Edison for services performed in the five boroughs of New York. He insures that his Foremen/Lead Mechanics have the proper information, qualifications and training to successfully execute the projects assigned. This also including the deployment and upkeep of vehicles and equipment, procurement and delivery and materials as well as ensuring permits, client authorization and budget approvals are in-place to proceed with the work.

Mr. DeMuccio's qualifications include Con Edison Gas Construction Control Mechanic - Operator Qualification that allows him to conduct all aspects of the gas maintenance, installation and service operations and complete plastic pipe fusion work up to 12 inches in diameter. He is also a certified Competent Person for trenching and excavation and hazardous waste site supervision.

Mr. DeMuccio has over 20 years of field project and management experience in the construction, utility and environmental remediation fields. Entering into the construction field in 1986 as a laborer he quickly rose through the ranks becoming a Foreman supervising crews with Hallen Construction Company, Inc in 1988 and eventually a Superintendent in 1998.

Mr. DeMuccio has managed and implemented new contracts for several Clients with monetary values totaling in the tens of millions of dollars. He is involved in all phases of gas installation, service and rehabilitation for major utilities in the New York Metropolitan area and has worked on numerous Hazardous Waste clean up projects including the Hexagon Labs remediation in the Bronx and at the September 11 2001 World Trade Center Terrorist attack site in Manhattan for Con Edison.

Previously as a General Foreman, Mr. DeMuccio ran field crews installing, repairing and rehabilitating gas mains and working on new service and other construction projects from 1988 to 1998 until promoted to Superintendent.
