As one of our most senior Superintendents, Mr. Fitzgerald's responsibilities include the scheduling, coordination, management and oversight of both employees and subcontractors involved with the temporary and permanent site restoration of project sites. This involves the planning and coordination with the other Superintendents, Foremen, site crews and Clients on the temporary and permanent restoration of between 45-50 work locations with temporary and permanent restorations completed at 25 sites per day. Temporary and permanent restoration can include the installation of temporary 'hot patch' asphalt to final restoration involving concrete, asphalt, cobble stone, brickwork, topsoil and seeding etc. These responsibilities extend further to ensuring that his crews and subcontractors have current and appropriate qualifications, training, certifications, safety equipment and materials for the task they are performing and as required by his Clients.

#### **Experience:**

Mr. Fitzgerald brings a wealth of knowledge and experience spanning over 19-years in the construction, utility and environmental remediation field and 21 years in customer service. Mr. Fitzgerald is currently a site restoration specialist but has had significant experience in the construction, subsurface utility, project, and office management areas. He has supervised more than 1,000 temporary and permanent site restorations since assuming this specialist role in October 2001. He has supervised major utility installations and rehabilitation projects in Brooklyn, Queens and Manhattan for KeySpan Energy and Con Edison from 1993 to 2001.

A summary of his previous experience begins with his employment with The Hallen Construction Co., Inc. in 1987 as the main hub office manager. There he held responsibilities that included assisting the superintendents with scheduling of labor, equipment and materials for up to 35 crews per day, assisted the maintenance department with the scheduling of preventative maintenance services for the \$10,000,000 fleet of company owned equipment inventory and completed daily equipment and daily payroll logs for employees.

Promoted in March 1993 to the position of Superintendent, Mr. Fitzgerald then managed between 60 and 80 personnel and 30-40 pieces of equipment to complete site work at an average of 15 locations daily for Utilities and other Clients. This work involved providing the supervision and pricing support to contracts with major utility companies for subsurface pipe leak detection, service installation and rehabilitation, repair of bell joints in standard keyhole openings, low and high pressure gas main installations, live gas tie-in work, relights and cathodic protection.

Working often in residential neighborhoods this work also involved significant coordination with both community and local regulatory agencies.
