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As a Superintendent working with Hallen Environmental Services, LLC., Mr. Yodice is responsible for the scheduling, deployment, management, safety and productivity of 10 to 15 crews and up to 20 pieces of equipment on between 10-15 project sites daily. Currently his primary Client responsibilities are for KeySpan Energy for services performed in Brooklyn and Queens. His key job responsibilities include ensuring that his Foremen/Lead Mechanics have the proper information, qualifications and training to successfully execute the projects assigned. This also includes the deployment and upkeep of vehicles and equipment, procurement and delivery of materials as well as ensuring permits, Client authorizations and budget approvals are in-place to proceed with the work. He is certified to complete excavation/trenching and hazardous waste work.

**Experience:**

Mr. Yodice has over 19 years of field project and management experience in the construction, utility and environmental remediation fields. Entering into the construction field in 1987 as a laborer he quickly rose through the ranks becoming a Foreman supervising crews with The Hallen Construction Co. Inc. in 1987 and subsequently a Superintendent in 2001.

Mr. Yodice has managed and implemented new contracts for several Clients with monetary values totaling in the tens of millions of dollars. He is involved in all phases of gas installation, service and rehabilitation for major utilities in the New York Metropolitan area and has worked on numerous Hazardous Waste clean up projects including at the September 11, 2001 World Trade Center Terrorist attack site in Manhattan for Con Edison.

Previously as a General Foreman, Mr. Yodice ran field crews installing, repairing and rehabilitating steel gas mains from 1988 to 1992. From 1992 until promoted to Superintendent in 2001 Mr. Yodice ran field crews on numerous sites removing older steel gas mains and replacing them with the newer plastic lines. During his time as a General Foreman Mr. Yodice completed hundreds of gas main service projects many of which were located in the busy streets of the five Boroughs in New York.
